



Terms of Service

Pearly Spurtle – Festival of Porridge

1. Acceptance of Terms

Welcome to the Pearly Spurtle – Festival of Porridge website ("Website"). By accessing or using this Website, purchasing tickets, entering competitions, registering as a volunteer, or participating in any event associated with the Pearly Spurtle – Festival of Porridge ("Festival"), you agree to be bound by these Terms of Service.

If you do not agree to these Terms, please do not use the Website or participate in Festival activities.

2. About the Festival

The Pearly Spurtle – Festival of Porridge is a volunteer-run community event held in Pearl Beach, New South Wales, Australia.

The Festival includes competitions, entertainment, food and beverage offerings, and community activities. All event details, schedules and activities are subject to change without notice.

3. Tickets and Event Registration

Ticket Purchases

- Tickets are subject to availability.
- Ticket prices are listed in Australian Dollars (AUD).
- Ticket purchases may be processed through a third-party ticketing provider.
- Entry may be refused if tickets have been transferred, altered or obtained fraudulently.

Refunds

Unless required by Australian Consumer Law:

- Tickets are non-refundable.
- Refunds will not be provided for changes in personal circumstances.
- If the Festival is cancelled by the organisers, ticket holders may be offered a refund or ticket transfer at the organisers' discretion.

Event Changes



The organisers reserve the right to:

- Change event schedules.
- Modify activities or entertainment.
- Substitute performers, judges or presenters.
- Alter competition formats where necessary.

4. Competition Entries

Eligibility

Competition entrants must:

- Complete the official registration process.
- Pay any applicable entry fees.
- Comply with published competition rules and judging requirements.

Judging

- Judges' decisions are final.
- No correspondence will be entered into regarding judging outcomes.
- Organisers reserve the right to disqualify entrants who fail to comply with competition rules.

Prizes

Prizes are awarded as described at the time of entry and may be subject to additional terms and conditions.

Where prizes include travel or third-party services, winners may be required to comply with additional supplier terms and conditions.

5. Participant Responsibility

Participants attend and compete at their own risk.

Entrants and attendees are responsible for:

- Following all safety instructions.
- Using equipment safely.
- Disclosing any dietary requirements or allergies where relevant.
- Ensuring they are physically capable of participating in Festival activities.



The organisers accept no responsibility for injury, loss or damage arising from participation except where required by law.
